Principal/Vice Principal

- Student population currently 440-450 but anticipate reaching 460 students. 13 English classes (55%) and 10 French classes (45%). Lots of new Kindies (3 English and 2 French classes).
- Second Learning Studio being built. Will take longer to build as it is being created from scratch but will have bathroom and sink.
- Teaching Vacancies four new posting open next week.
- Counselling time for kids position increase from 0.3 to 0.7 hours and Youth and Family Counsellor will be 2.5 days/ week.
- Nature's Way Program district program that helps kids with anxiety by connecting them to nature to increase mindfulness. Grade 4 & 5 students eligible. A mixture of kids will be chosen based on teacher and counselor recommendations and will ensure students from aboriginal ancestry are included.
- passed during the summer a celebration of life was held during the summer, but the school would like to do more.
- Playground equipment previously, government announced new equipment for September 2018 but will be delayed ensuring consultation with PAC, parents, and allow for grants to be written. Will be at same location and be inclusive.
- Nature based playground opportunity to compliment new playground equipment. Bonnie contacted Board with proposal and hoping more options will be generated. Occupational and physio therapists have also been consulted to ensure as much inclusivity as possible but still challenging for all students.
- Field now open, after holes put in ground and irrigation system put in.

- **Communication** from school will move to electronic format and away from paper as this saves costs and environmentally friendly.
- New technology will allow text messages to phones directing parents to website for info on events.
- Emergency supplies stocked and organized by PAC in SEACAN. Looking to add blankets.
- Reunification practice will be offsite. Buddy system will be used. Feedback welcomed.
- Share concerns re your kids with Principle and V-Principle as they want to hear from parents and help.
- Aboriginal drums have been purchased. Grade 5's will be invited to practice.
- Cross country running will start soon.
- **Swimming lessons** for Grade 3's (whole class goes including split classes) starts soon. Jump Start donated \$2,500. Will alternate between English and French students.
