Using this as a short cut has led to the aforementioned near misses. We also have parents parking in the lot during pick up; this practice needs to stop. I will again draw your attention to the fact that this is a one exit/entrance lot and we have folks that are off to second jobs or picking up kids from school only to be blocked in as someone tries to park at the end of the day.

Open PAC Positions

All families are automatically members of the PAC, and the PAC is governed by a board. All Board positions are up for election annually in June. Our PAC has been experiencing turnover as students leave for middle school. There are at least three empty seats on our PAC board for the 2020/21 school year, and a possibility of no PAC board if people choose not to return. If the PAC doesn't have a board, we risk losing out on about \$10,000 in gaming grants for our school, which are used to fund school buses for field trips, sports equipment, and other important opportunities. It also means that there will be no one to run PAC meetings, and coordinate many of our community events. This is not a substantial time commitment and positions can be shared!!
