

Dear Parents and Guardians,

We are intending on rebuilding classes as we are just now receiving the results from the recent safe-return-to-school survey that was sent out to families of students in grades 1 through 5.. If you did not fill out a survey, we will proceed as though you are intending for your child to return to full time, in-class instruction. If this is not the case, please contact the school **immediately** to let us know your choice. The options are indicated at the bottom of this message.

Please note that all of our French Immersion students are welcome to choose the hybrid option, however, French language programming will not be supported in this model. The hybrid model focus will be literacy and numeracy within the English model.
