Hello Quadra families!

I would like to welcome all of our staff, students and families to a new school year, with a special welcome to those of you who are new to our Quadra family. You are joining a wonderful school community and I am confident Quadra will provide a positive and successful experience for each of you.

I wanted to send this message out today with some preliminary information about the upcoming school year. I will send another message next week with more details about the first day of school, etc. Earlier this week, I sent you an email with an attachment from the Ministry updating health and safety guidelines for the upcoming school year.

In summary, you should know:

- All staff and students should complete the health assessment prior to coming to school daily.
- Masks must be worn indoors by all K-12 school staff unless there is a medical exemption
- Students in Grades 4-12 are required to wear a mask indoors or on school busses
- Students in Kindergarten through Grade 3 are encouraged to wear a mask indoors and while on school busses
- Hand washing is required frequently including:
 - When students arrive at school
 - Before and after any breaks
 - Before and after eating and drinking (excluding drinks kept at a student's desk – water for example)
 - Before and after using an indoor learning space used by multiple classes (e.g. the gym, music room, library etc.)
 - After using the toilet
 - o After sneezing or coughing into their hands
 - Whenever hands are visibly dirty
- All regular educational and extra-curricular activities can proceed as usual as long as they adhere to COVID 19 provincial guidelines as outlined in the BCCDC documents.

The following will be different from last year:

- School athletics will be allowed to return, provided we follow relevant health guidelines. (More details about school athletics will follow in the future)
- There will be no learning cohorts or staggered recesses

• Physical distancing (2 meter/6 feet) will not be required, but we will encourage everyone to respect each other's personal space and will encourage as much learning as possible to occur outdoors.
