
#### WE NEED YOUR TALENTS!!

Here follows a description of the presentation, and a little about Allison Rees:

*Effective communication* creates an atmosphere of emotional safety for everyone. Anyone working with children should have this course (or something like it) under their belt. Our words are powerful and can have a tremendous positive or negative impact. Listening to children effectively (or to anyone) helps them mature emotionally and to develop empathy. This covers: Listening, Speaking, Resolving Issues and Coaching Techniques. Many power struggles in families can be eliminated by developing these skills.

**Allison Rees** has been **teaching LIFE Seminars courses since 1993.** Countless parents and professionals attend these popular courses through word of mouth alone. LIFE Seminars have been a staple of family education for over forty years! Allison's articles regularly appear in Parenting Today, and of course Island Parent Magazine with her monthly Cut it Outs. She has co-authored **two books**, Sidestepping the Power Struggle and The Parent Child Connection. Allison has been **featured as the expert** on various television programs and was the co-host of the Island Parent Radio Show for twelve years.

Allison's presentations are **down to earth, honest and to the point.** Lectures are packed with insights, humor and rich interactions with participants. While her subjects are pre-planned, her lectures are not, which is why people don't tire of the material when they repeat the courses. She has **supported**

### District Calendar Approved for 2022-2023 School Year

**VICTORIA, BC** – The Board of Education and the Ministry of Education have approved the 2022-2023 school year calendar. The calendar highlights school openings, vacation breaks, the last day of classes, and non-instructional days including the National Day for Truth and Reconciliation.

The calendar was developed in collaboration with Sooke (#62) and Saanich (#63) school districts in an effort to align important dates as much as possible. The District also sought public input on the calendar for 30 days prior to finalizing.
