Catch-up Grade 1 and 2 Immunizations

To make routine immunization more accessible to children, Island Health is trialing in-school immunization clinics for students in grades 1 and 2 at select schools. Eligible grade 1 and 2 students will be receiving a consent package through the school shortly (first week of June). If your child receives a package, follow the instructions included and return the signed consent form to the school. Parents/guardians may provide consent or refusal for each/all immunizations. Parents/guardians are welcome to be with their child at the school; however, there is no expectation to be present.

Please note: This clinic will **not** include COVID-19 immunizations.

Immunizations will be provided at Quadra Elementary School on Tuesday June 20, 2023.
