This spring, we are offering the opportunity for students in Grades 4 and 5 to be evaluated for characteristics of giftedness. The Gifted Student Identification Process is intended to help identify the portion of the student population that may be designated as “Gifted” (approx. 3%). The overall identification process involves the completion of three surveys, as well as the OLSAT (Otis-Lennon School Ability Test), which will take place at school during school hours on May 9th.
