 - Read anywhere: on holiday, at home, at the beach, etc.
- Record your daily reading for 7 weeks:
 - 1 light = 1 day of reading
 - 7 lights = 1 week of reading
- Come back to the library to collect your weekly sticker and prize at any GVPL branch upon completing your 7 days of reading.
- Repeat until you've completed 7 weeks of reading. Congratulations!
